44. QUALITY OF TEACHING & LEARNING

Work on the observations continues, and at present there were no major concerns. Personalisation was proving effective, and undertaken in pairs with SLT members.

SLT members added that pupil case studies were being undertaken in class, currently five pupils had been targeted, but all children will have a unique personalisation plan. This dovetailed into the School Development Plan.

The SLT were currently reviewing lesson observations for greater flexibility and were working with teachers and HLTAs

Teaching staff had also expressed that greater partnership working was working well.

45. STANDARDS

The new monitoring system was working well, elements of data provided key information, but had also thrown up a number of questions, one of which being the quality of the evidence supplied.

The school was working with 3 other schools to assist with the production of robust targets.


46. DATE OF NEXT MEETING
