

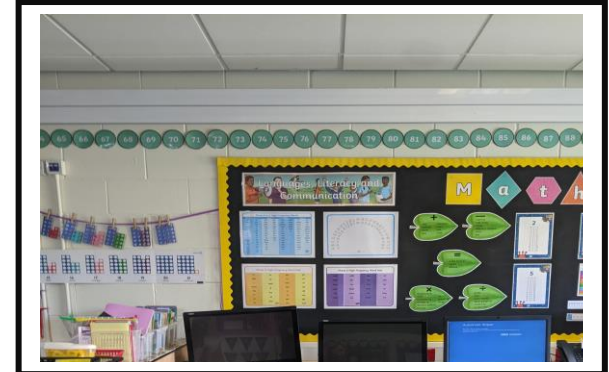

What Happens in Our Class?
